Service Relaunch

Daybreak Community Church is fully committed to ensuring a clean, safe experience for our visitors and staff, that adheres to Alberta Health and Safety (AHS) Guidelines. To that end the following procedures will be used to safely conduct worship services:

- A maximum number of 50 attendees per service will be allowed.
- Attendees are required to register ahead of time and must indicate that they've read and agreed to follow the church's rules during the service. Prior to visiting the church, guests must ensure that they are not experiencing the [most common symptoms of COVID-19](#)
- Clear COVID-19 signage will be posted at the entrance/exit and throughout the facility.
- Guests will be asked to maintain a 2-meter physical distance between members of different households or cohorts.
- The wearing of masks is required while within the facility.
- Staged departures from the sanctuary, in small groups, will be used after services to avoid overcrowding.
- Congregational singing is highly discouraged, at this stage, so congregants are asked to just hum and use the time to reflect and pray.
- Some areas of the facility, such as the nursing room, may be closed to the public.
- Activities such as baptism and communion are prohibited at this stage.
- Hugging and shaking of hands are discouraged.
- There will be no Children's Ministry outside the service at this time. Families are encouraged to bring activities for children that can be done at tables.

Ongoing Cleaning and Sanitization

- Hand sanitizer stations will be placed in several places for guests to use.
- High touch areas such as door handles and light switches will be spray disinfected with a Health Canada Approved QUAT solution, on a regular basis.
- Restrooms will be limited to a set number of 2 users at a time and will be cleaned and disinfected (including handles and other touch points) frequently.
